



## WEEK IN REVIEW

- NOVEMBER 16, 1945: The first group of Soldiers from the 37th Infantry Division begins to depart the Philippines for the United States.
- NOVEMBER 17, 1775: The Artillery branch is established when the Continental Congress unanimously elects Henry Knox "Colonel of the Regiment of Artillery." Both the Field Artillery and Air Defense Artillery branches celebrate this birthday.
- NOVEMBER 18, 1921: Company H, 134th Support Battalion is organized in Akron as Troop I, 1st Cavalry Regiment.

## **81MM MORTAR CARTRIDGE**

This 81MM mortar cartridge has been painted by Howitzer Battery, 2d Squadron, 107th Armored Cavalry, circa 1980. Mounted for display on an oak board, the cartridge is painted with the unit designation and crossed cannons with a skull in the center. Near the cannons it reads, "2ND TO NONE. TIMELY. ACCURATE. DEADLY." On the reverse is painted "Donated by Captain Dunn and Painted By Dan "Scotty" Donovan."

Howitzer Battery was stationed in Alliance, Ohio from 1977 to 1993 and is the ancestor to Company H, 134th Support Battalion, which is celebrating its 100th anniversary this week.
