MAY 13, 1920: Company A,

ORGANIZATIONAL COLORS, 737TH MAINTENANCE BATTALION, 1963

These recently recovered organizational colors were issued to the 737th Maintenance Battalion in 1963. With the ROAD (Reorganization Objective Army Divisions) construct, division ordnance battalions were redesignated as maintenance battalions that year. The colors are divided horizontally with crimson on top and brick red on the bottom. Crimson is the branch color of the ordnance corps. This set of colors was used by the battalion until 1972, when it was converted from a battalion with organic companies to a battalion headquarters with separate companies assigned as needed. At that time, regulations prescribed a different design for nonorganic battalions.
