



WEEK IN REVIEW

AUGUST 28-30, 1862: The Second Battle of Bull Run takes place, with Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee's Army of Northern Virginia defeating Union Maj. Gen. John Pope's Army of Virginia. Eleven infantry regiments, one cavalry regiment and three light artillery batteries represented Ohio in Pope's force.

<u>AUGUST 29, 1917</u>: Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 16th Engineer Brigade and Headquarters and Special Troops Battalion, 371st Sustainment Brigade are constituted as Headquarters, 62d Field Artillery Brigade.

Th <u>SEPTEMBER 1, 1963</u>: Company C, 837th Engineer Battalion is organized in Oxford as Battery B, 1st Missile Battalion, 137th Artillery.

<u>SEPTEMBER 1, 1994</u>: Detachment 21, Operational Support Airlift Command is organized in Columbus.

<u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2005</u>: Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 112th Transportation Battalion is constituted in North Canton.

<u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2005</u>: The Ohio National Guard launches Operation Buckeye in support of Hurricane Katrina recovery efforts. About 350 Soldiers of Joint Task Force Buckeye are transported to Louisiana on Ohio Air National Guard KC-135 and C-130 aircraft.

<u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2007</u>: The 137th Signal Company is organized in Newark as Signal Company, 371st Sustainment Brigade.

<u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2008</u>: The 1937th Support Detachment is constituted in Columbus.
