




## **WEEK IN REVIEW**

## **GUIDON, COMPANY C, 372D ENGINEER BATTALION**

The final guidon used by Lebanon's Company C, 372d Engineer Battalion before the unit's 1994 reorganization to Troop B, 2d Squadron, 107th Cavalry. The scarlet swallow-tailed unit marker contains the branch insignia castle of the engineers with the unit designation above the device and the company letter below it. The unit was under this designation from 1972 to 1994.
