Chief Master Sergeant Heidi A. Bunker is the eleventh State Command Chief Master Sergeant for the Ohio Air National Guard, Joint Force Headquarters, Columbus, Ohio. Chief Bunker advises The Adjutant General and his staff on all matters influencing mission readiness, professional development, proper utilization, health, morale and welfare of the Ohio Air National Guards 4,700 enlisted Airmen and their families. This includes four Air Wings, and six Geographically Separated Units that serve our communities, state, and nation for homeland defense and federal missions.

Chief Bunker entered military service in October 1991 and was assigned to the 179th Aerial Port Squadron, Air National Guard Base in Mansfield, Ohio as an Air Transportation Specialist. Chief Bunker was selected as a First Sergeant and completed the USAF First Sergeant's Academy in residence. She served in the capacity of a First Sergeant between 2007 - 2014 where she served the 179th Aerial Port Squadron, 179th Logistics Readiness Squadron, the 179th Air Wing and the 164th Operations Group. She served in this position until her appointment to the Human Resources Advisor for the 179th Airlift Wing where she was tasked with ensuring a culture of inclusion and diversity and as part of that role, she served on the Joint Inclusion Diversity Executive Council at the Joint Force Headquarters in Columbus, Ohio. Chief Bunker served in this position until her appointment to the Mission Support Group Superintendent position where she provided leadership and management in organizing, equipping and training enlisted personnel. Prior to her current position, Chief



Bunker was the 178th Wing Command Chief Master Sergeant, Springfield, Ohio. In this role, she advised the Wing Commander on all matters influencing mission readiness, professional development, proper utilization, health, morale and welfare for the 178th Wing's enlisted force. Chief Bunker is currently the lead facilitator for the Chief Master Sergeant Orientaion Course, Joint Base Andrews AFB, MD. Chief Bunker has deployed in support of Operations HURRICAN KATRINA, IRAQI FREEDOM AND ENDURING FREEDOM.
