What do I do if I have been assaulted?

- Go to a safe location away from the perpetrator and call 911 if appropriate.
- 2. Seek medical care as soon as possible.
 - a. You may have injuries or be at risk of pregnancy or sexually transmitted infection.
 - b. Medical staff to conduct a sexual assault forensic examination to preserve evidence
 - c. If you suspect you had been drugged, request that a urine sample be collected.
 - d. Preserve all evidence of the assault.
 - e. Do not bathe, wash your hands or brush your teeth. Do not clean or straighten up the crime scene.
