

# STAY GUARD AND SERVE

Learn about all the rewarding opportunities that are available to you in the Ohio Army National Guard. This could mean a lump-sum bonus for a 6-, 4- or 2-year extention in your service commitment. Or a new career opportunity by changing your Unit or MOS, or by pursuing an advancement into the officer corps. And before you step away from military service, be sure you have taken full advantage of the education and employment programs available to you and your family members.

#### **CHANGE YOUR MOS**

If you'd like to experience something new and learn additional skills, consider changing your MOS. Successfully reclassing could offer more opportunities for promotion, a transfer to a new unit, and/or certification in new career skills. Talk to your brigade career counselor to see what positions are available.

#### **CHANGE YOUR UNIT**

Transferring to a new unit could mean shorter drives to drill, new opportunities and different missions. With 107 Army Guard units occupying 44 training sites/areas across the state, a change of location is an option to consider.

## **EARN YOUR RE-ENLISTMENT EXTENTION BONUS (REB)**

Army National Guard Soldiers who extend or immediately re-enlist may be eligible for the Re-enlistment Extension Bonus, provided in one lump sum. The bonus is available for both deployed and stateside Soldiers.
