WEEK IN REVIEW

M APRIL 1, 1925: Company A, 237th Support Battalion is organized in Cleveland as Troop G, 107th Cavalry.

APRIL 1, 1963: The 37th Infantry Division is reorganized under the ROAD (Reorganization of Army Divisions) tables of organization and equipment. ROAD divisions consisted of three infantry brigades, division artillery and division trains.

APRIL 1, 1980: Rickenbacker Air Force Base is transferred from the United States Air Force's Strategic Air Command to the Ohio Air National Guard.

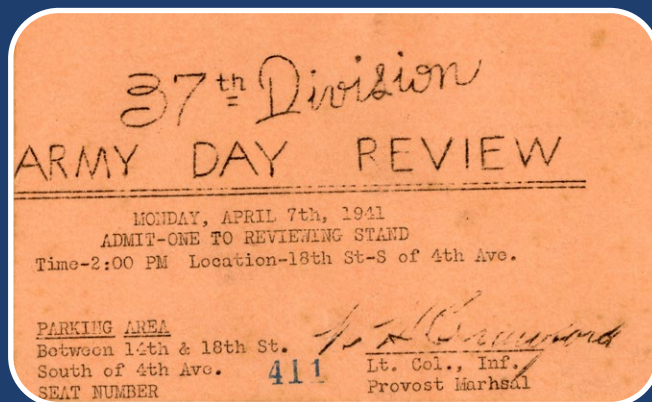
APRIL 1, 1998: The 1485th Transportation Company is constituted as Detachment 2, 1485th Transportation Company.

Sa APRIL 6-7, 1862: Maj. Gen. Ulysses S. Grant's Army of the Tennessee defeats Confederate forces at the Battle of Shiloh, Tenn. Ohioans made up about one-fifth of Grant's army, representing 28 infantry regiments, five batteries of artillery and a cavalry regiment.

APRIL 6, 1892: The 1194th Engineer Company is organized in Chillicothe as Company H, 17th Infantry Regiment (Sill Guard).

37TH DIVISION ARMY DAY REVIEW PASS

This pass admitted one viewer to the 37th Division Army Day Review at Camp Shelby, Miss. The Reveille, the official paper of Camp Shelby, reported that thousands of local people visited the camp for the day's activities. In addition to the afternoon review, Soldiers from the 38th Division put on demonstrations in troop areas for those in attendance. Schools in the surrounding cities closed and an estimated 20,000 visitors witnessed the parade by the Buckeye Division.
