Any member of the public who wishes to speak before the commission, will fill out a witness testimony slip the day of the meeting.



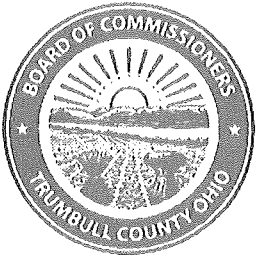


