## Ohio National Guard Soldier "Hero of the Year" recipient

What:

The Ohio National Guard and Jackson Hewitt Tax Service joins Mayor Michael B. Coleman to celebrate Command Sgt. Maj. David G. Collins, CSM (retired), Ohio Army National Guard, as one of a select group of honorees named in the Jackson Hewitt National Guard "Heroes of the Year" nationwide campaign. CSM Collins is the first and only candidate chosen from Ohio as part of this national search.

Jackson Hewitt's "Heroes of the Year" award provides the opportunity for people to nominate a loved one, friend or neighbor who serves in the Army National Guard to be selected for the opportunity of a lifetime – the chance to have his or her image featured on a NASCAR race car during a 2007 NASCAR Nextel Cup Series Race. This is the first time that a non-celebrity's image will be featured on a NASCAR race car!
