Assistant Adjutant General Visits Serbia

WHO: Brig. Gen. Matthew L. Kambic, Ohio Assistant Adjutant General - Army, will lead a small delegation to Serbia as the inaugural event for the State Partnership Program with Serbia November 26 – 30, 2006.

WHAT: Upon arrival the delegation will meet with members of the Ministry of Defense to overview organization and role of the National Guard in providing military support to civil authorities. The program will include the National Response Plan and the organization of the Ohio National Guard and how it works with state and local partnership to plan for and execute operations in support of the citizens of Ohio and the United States.

While in the Republic of Serbia, the delegation will continue to discuss future opportunities to promote the partnership that was established earlier this year. The State Partnership Program, a U.S. European Command initiative, in conjunction with the National Guard Bureau, links National Guard states with partner countries to foster mutual interests and long-term relationships across all levels of society.
