Ohio National Guard engineer detachment to deploy

NEWTON FALLS—Approximately 40 Soldiers from the 292nd Engineer Detachment, will mobilize from Newton Falls, Ohio, in late September and travel to Fort McCoy, Wis., to conduct individual and collective training, culminating with a comprehensive validation of every Soldier's ability to effectively perform their assigned duty. The 292nd will ultimately deploy to Iraq in support of Operation New Dawn.

The 292nd Engineer Detachment was activated on Sept. 1, 2007 as part of the Ohio Army National Guard to conduct asphalt paving missions in support of military operations. The unit was federally recognized on Dec. 1, 2007 at Newton Falls, Ohio. This is the first mobilization for the unit.
