Ohio National Guard medical unit to deploy

COLUMBUS, Ohio—About 75 Soldiers from the Ohio Army National Guard's 684th Area Support Medical Company are scheduled to mobilize for active duty this month in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan.

The public is invited to the unit's call to duty ceremony at noon Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011, at the Westerville North High School, 950 County Line Road, Westerville, OH. 43081.

Following the ceremony, the Soldiers will depart for their mobilization station at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Wash. to prepare for deployment.
