Buckeyes to honor Ohio National Guard, other service branches as part of annual military appreciation game

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio State University will honor Ohio National Guard Soldiers and Airmen, as well as other U.S. military service members, before and during its football game with Florida A&M at noon Saturday in Ohio Stadium.
