## **Ohio National Guard's 122nd Army Band rock ensemble to perform in concert at Rock and Roll Hall of Fame**

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The 122nd Army Band rock ensemble, known as "Flashbang," will perform in concert at 9:30 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 24, 2015, at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum in Cleveland.

The band will perform at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame as part of the fifth and last semi-final round of the Tri-C High School Rock Off, a high school rock band competition that is in its 19th year. At each semi-final round, eight rock bands comprised of high school students from Northeast Ohio strive to place as one of the top three bands, so they can return Feb. 7 to compete in the "Final Exam."

The 122nd Army Band's performance will be an exhibition, not as part of the Rock Off competition.

The concerts at the Rock Hall are open to all ages and the \$10 admission ticket to the Rock Off includes admission to the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum exhibits on performance days.
