- WHO:** The Ohio National Guard, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Health, Noble County Health Department, Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center, Marietta Memorial Hospital and Genesis Healthcare System.
- WHAT:** GuardCare, with free health services including immunizations, physicals, women's health services, dental examinations and hearing and vision testing.
- WHEN:** 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 10
8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 11
- WHERE:** Noble County Fairgrounds, County Road 56, Caldwell, Ohio 43724.
- BACKGROUND:** [GuardCare](#) is hosted each year in a different medically-underserved Ohio community. Services are free to all Ohio residents who attend, regardless of income. No appointment is necessary and insurance is not needed or considered.

Through GuardCare, Ohio National Guard medical personnel support and assist local health care providers. The event also enhances the medical skills of Ohio National Guard medical personnel, many of whom work as health care professionals in their civilian occupations as well.
