New video program showcases the Ohio National Guard

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Buckeye Guard, a venerable publication of the Adjutant General's Department for more than 40 years, published in a print magazine format from 1976 to 2011, has been revamped for our digital society.

A video version of the Buckeye Guard will begin airing on The Ohio Channel, a service of Ohio's public broadcasting stations, on Monday, Jan. 16. Scheduled airdates are Mondays at 12:15 and 8:15 p.m. and Saturdays at 9 a.m.

The inaugural edition will include a behind-the-scenes look at annual training exercises, a celebration of a decade-long partnership with Serbia, and trailblazers in the Ohio Army and Air National Guard.

The Ohio Channel combines Statehouse coverage with locally produced PBS programs to give a statewide perspective on issues that affect the lives of all Ohioans.
