Ohio National Guard to support 58th Presidential Inauguration

COLUMBUS, OH – The Ohio National Guard will send about 20 Soldiers and Airmen from throughout the state to provide support to the 58th Presidential Inauguration Jan. 20 in Washington, D.C.

Ohio National Guard members will be providing chaplain and food service support. They will join hundreds of National Guard members from 40 other states and territories who have been tasked with providing several different types of support at the inauguration event.

Chaplain support will conduct religious and counseling support to the service members supporting the event.

Food service support will operate Single Pallet Expeditionary Kitchens (SPEKs) to provide daily meals to service members supporting the event.
