Ohio National Guard's 204th Engineer Detachment to return home

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio National Guard will welcome home about 10 Soldiers from the 204th Engineer Detachment, headquartered in Columbus, as they return from a nearly yearlong deployment in support of Operation Freedom's Sentinel.

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 4:30 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 28 at Reynoldsburg High School, 6699 E. Livingston Avenue, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068.

Soldiers of the 204th Engineer Detachment provided theater-level construction management as part of the Command Material Recovery Element (CRME). The 204th performed more than 50 deconstruction and demolition projects throughout Afghanistan and completed the engineer scope of work and design for 15 large-scale projects during the deployment.
