Ohio National Guard Soldier from Northeast Ohio dies during training

COLUMBUS, Ohio — An Ohio National Guard member has died at a training facility in Indiana.

Capt. Brian A. Stillman, 43, of Norton, Ohio collapsed while training at Camp Atterbury in Edinburgh, Indiana shortly after 12:30 p.m. Friday, March 10. Efforts to revive Stillman were unsuccessful. The cause of his death is under investigation and no further details are available at this time.

Stillman was a 19-year member of the Ohio Army National Guard and an operations officer for the 2nd Battalion, 174th Air Defense Artillery Regiment. He is survived by his wife and two children.

The entire Ohio National Guard is mourning the loss of a fallen brother and would ask for understanding and privacy toward his family and friends during the grieving process.
