## **Ohio National Guard to conduct helicopter training operations this week in Central Ohio area**

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio National Guard will conduct flight operations involving UH-60 Black Hawk and CH-47 Chinook helicopters July 25-27, between 1 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. each day, in the greater Columbus area to include water exercises at Alum Creek State Park.

Those living in and around the Franklin, Delaware and Morrow county areas may hear and/or see helicopters in close proximity to civilian areas. These are routine training operations being conducted to maintain readiness of Ohio National Guard rotary-wing aviation equipment and personnel.

Although scheduled for the evening, the exercise flights could be delayed or cancelled due to inclement weather.
