Ohio National Guard's 37th Infantry Brigade Combat Team to return home

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio National Guard will welcome home about 100 Soldiers from Headquarters, 37th Infantry Brigade Combat Team, located in Columbus, as they return from a nearly yearlong deployment in support of Operation Joint Guard-Kosovo Force (KFOR).

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 4 p.m. Saturday, July 29 at Gahanna-Lincoln High School, 140 South Hamilton Road, Gahanna, OH 43230.

The Soldiers of the 37th were deployed for one year to Kosovo for United Nations peacekeeping operations. While there, the 37th IBCT provided command and supervisory oversight of Multinational Battle Group-East (MNBG-E), which was tasked with maintaining a safe and secure environment and ensuring freedom of movement for people living within the MNBG-E Area of Responsibility, the sector along Kosovo's southeastern boundary that it shares with Macedonia and Serbia.
