- WHAT:** Media availability at GuardCare, a free healthcare event open to the public.
- WHEN:** Saturday, Aug. 12 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

- BACKGROUND:** [GuardCare](#) is hosted each year in a different medically-underserved Ohio community. Services are free to all who attend, regardless of income. No appointment is necessary and insurance is not needed or considered.

The Union County GuardCare will be open to the public Saturday, Aug. 12 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday, Aug. 13 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Services will include immunizations, sports physicals, women's health services, and hearing and vision testing.

Through GuardCare, Ohio National Guard medical personnel support and assist local health care providers. The event also enhances the medical skills of Ohio National Guard medical personnel, many of whom work as health care professionals in their civilian occupations as well.
