Ohio National Guard's 323rd Military Police Company to return home

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio National Guard will welcome home about 80 Soldiers from the 323rd Military Police Company, located in Toledo, as they return from a nearly yearlong deployment in support of Operation Inherent Resolve.

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 5:30 p.m. Friday, Oct. 13 at Cedar Creek Church, 29129 Lime City Road, Perrysburg, Ohio 43551.

While deployed, the Soldiers of the 323rd MP Company conducted operations in support of U.S. European Command in Turkey. Operation Inherent Resolve is the U.S. military's operational name for the military intervention against the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria, including both the campaign in Iraq and the campaign in Syria.
