Ohio National Guard's 1-148th Infantry Regiment to return home

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The Ohio National Guard will welcome home more than 300 Soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 148th Infantry Regiment, headquartered in Walbridge, Ohio, as they return 10 months after leaving for joint training with the Jordan Armed Forces-Arab Army.

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 6 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 29 at the Stranahan Theater, 4645 Heatherdowns Blvd., Toledo, Ohio 43614.

Elements of the battalion have deployed six times since the beginning of the War on Terrorism. The battalion, or parts of it, has been mobilized in support of Operation Noble Eagle (2001), KFOR6A - Kosovo (2004), Operation Iraqi Freedom (2006), KFOR8 - Kosovo (2006), Operation Iraqi Freedom (2008) and Operation Enduring Freedom-Afghanistan (2012).
