1. Old Business:
 - a. Exercises during Technician work week
 - i. Need to ensure all exercises (ORE, ORI, FPCON, etc) are coordinated thru partnership to discuss impact on Technician work force. This will be accomplished for future exercises. Item closed
2. New Business:
 - a. UCI Technician work schedule: The following was agreed upon for the 3 thru 7 April work week:
 - i. Individuals working 4 10s would change their work week from Monday thru Thursday to Tuesday thru Friday.
 - ii. Individuals working 5 8s would not have to change their work schedule.
 - iii. The unit will fly Tuesday thru Friday with no night flying that week.
 - b. It was agreed and encouraged that Liberal leave is allowed on the Friday before Easter.
 - c. Wing hats were discussed. The Wing is waiting on the manufacturer to provide samples of hats. It can then be determined which one will be the official Wing hat and permission will be requested from the Wing Commander to authorize wear of the hat.
 - d. The draft Wing Instruction for Energy Management and Conservation was approved. Mike Haas and Tambra Lipper will sign the coordination sheet for the Local Partnership Committee (LPC) and it will be forwarded to Wing Information Management.

- e. Col Schart briefed the LPC on the fact that our utility costs are down 2.5% from what we have spent this time last year. The 200th was also down by 7.3%. The rest of the units in the state saw increases. Col Schart expressed his appreciation for what everyone is doing to cut costs and conserve energy. The Partnership will present this information to the base, and stress the importance to continue their efforts in conserving energy.
 - f. It was also suggested and approved that we receive quarterly updates from the building Managers in regards to updates/changes to their buildings or other items that may influence energy conservation.
 - g. The LPC will also follow up with Maj Gieze and Maj Bixler to see if the Wing is requesting funding to modify buildings improve heating/cooling systems, and to zone buildings that are not already zoned.
 - h. Col Schart also mentioned that the Wing received \$2.5 Million for research and development in the area of energy. A meeting with Representative Marcy Kaptur, Col Schart and Maj Gieze occurred explaining the possible uses of this money and what it was for. No action was required by the LPC as this was informational only.
3. The next meeting of the LPC will be on 14 March at 1400 in the Wing Commanders Conference room
