2. Topics of Discussion:

a. Energy Budget


1. Monthly Energy Report: Natural Gas: At the end of the November 2006, the 180th FW has expended 20.1% of the Natural Gas Budget, while consuming 23.2% of the total anticipated Natural Gas requirements for the year. This represents an increase in consumption of 2% from FY 06 to FY 07. This increase is probably being caused due to heating 2 LRS complex at the current time.


- ii. Electric: At the end of the November 2006, the 180th FW has expended 15.2% of the Electric Budget, while consuming 16.5% of the total anticipated Electric requirements for the year. This represents a consistent use of electricity from FY 06 to FY 07. The unit has experienced a 1% increase in electric cost in FY 07 versus FY 06, which is probably caused the 1% increase in electric cost for this period.

- iii. Overall Budget: Currently the base has spent \$3,400 more in FY 07 than for the same point in time in FY 06. Unit leadership will continue to review utility consumption and expenditures to ensure the established budget can be achieved.



- iv. Overall Energy Consumption: The base’s energy use for FY 2007 indicates that the wing’s goal of a 2% reduction per fiscal year may not be achieved by a slight amount. Continuous review and monitoring by unit leadership will assist in meeting unit goals.



- b. Labor-Management Training:
 - i. Danko still requires LPC training.
 - ii. The JPEC state wide web page is operational.
- c. State Smoking Law: The LPC reviewed the new Adjutant General’s policy in regards to the State of Ohio’s Smoking Ban. The following was done to bring the base in compliance:
 - i. The CES is to contact all unit commanders/supervisors and building managers and ensure the new policy is enforced on all facilities.
 - ii. The LPC voted to eliminate LPC #3 as it has been superseded by the new policy memorandum.
- d. Hiring Boards: Inconsistency in the manner in which technician/AGR hiring board are being conducted has been identified by several individuals. Brent Leimenstoll and Claudia Jones are going to work with Keith Czop and review the requirements provided to the wing from State HRO in regards to selection boards. A generic template may be created to assist selecting officials and selection board chairmen in the manner in which the boards are being conducted. Presentation to be made for discussion at next LPC meeting.
- e. Have aircraft in chocks by 1100 on the first Tues of the month. It originally was Wednesday but we will be flying Wed and Thursday nights after the first of the year. Mike Haas to coordinate with Maj. Ohm and see if this can be worked into schedule. To be presented at next LPC meeting.
- f. NSPS Updates: Pay banding to become final for non-bargaining unit GS employees in FY 07.
- g. Technician TDY vs. Military TDY: The status used for the various TDYs will need to be discussed as these opportunities present themselves. Currently on hold for Green Flag until funding requests can be finalized.
- h. Technician Christmas Party: Being conducted off base this year. Input will be taken by the Christmas Party planning committee for suggested improvements.
