Purpose

Review

Minutes from the __11 March 2008 _ meeting were reviewed and accepted.

2. Item

Discussion: Work schedules at CSMS and DSCC. Due to the inclusion of former FMS. Personnel and a difference in work schedules than what was traditional at CSMS Newark, there was a discussion on whether or not to adopt their Monday or Friday off 4-10 schedules or maintain CSMS Monday only off schedule.

Action: The agreement to adopt the FMS work schedule was met without objection and will be implemented in an orderly manner after the completion of Annual Training.

Item

Discussion: Were to place the smoking shelter at DSCC and what will the fabrication of this shelter look like to appease the State of Ohio's ban on smoking.

Action: A location was agreed upon but the LPC needs clarification on the make up of a legal smoking shelter.

Item

Discussion: Computer and RCAS access for employees at the DSCC location due to limited resources it is hard for personnel to access computers for automotive parts research and RCAS access.

Action: Research a fielding plan that will allow for more computers in the facility and supervisor will allow more access to computers as much as possible.

Item

Discussion: Composition of LPC between Newark and DSCC. The discussion revolved around whether or not to have two LPC's or a combined between both locations. We discussed the responsibilities of the LPC's and how it would affect two locations. Our decision to maintain one combined LPC was reached because of the fear of a lack of fluid representation and a conflict over differences in policy when the shops eventually consolidate.

Item


