1. <i>Previous Minutes</i>	<i>Review</i>

2. <i>Item: Safety Council Composition;</i>	<i>Update</i>

The composition will have equal representation at both facilities (Newark and Columbus); with Newark having a council President and Columbus having a Vice President There will be Labor Representative from the LPC to give feed back to the LPC.
