### Old Business:

1. Shortage of MSD's and ETM readers. – Ongoing issue that is still being worked on with J4, J6 and SASMO in the Automation Working Group.
2. Unique CSMS connectivity issues to support upgrade of systems. – Ongoing issue that is still being worked on with J4, J6 and SASMO in the Automation Working Group.
3. Coverall cleaning and issue of 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> set from CIF. – It was agreed to see how many employees actually use the coverall cleaning and track turnaround time from vendor to see is additional coveralls are needed. Only a total of 3 employees between both shops use program now. Memo signed by USPFO authorizing 3<sup>rd</sup> set by name has been distributed to supervisors.
4. Review of safety related issues. a.) Newark fuel ventilation system is still not repaired from 29 October 2010, RAC II issue. –Not getting fixed, brief precautions to Section. d.) Water still entering under doors in work bays, Main Street and front door, RAC III. –Main Street needs included in bids, front door is sealed.
5. Cell phone usage. – Some employees abuse the right to have a cell phone by using it excessively through the work day. Labor and management will meet to discuss this issue with a facilitator on 3 August 2011 at Newark.

### New Business:


1. Union Official Time Tracking. – Will start tracking official times for Union next pay period (31 July 2011).
