Old Business:

Continued discussion on issue 2007-04.

Issue 2007-04 Why is it not possible for on-board techs to transfer to another shop with out going through the interview process. They already accomplished this to be an on-board Tech.

On this Issue the LPC members see two issues. Issue One: is out of our scope, as the technician applied for the position in question and was not selected. Technician needs to ask for a back brief from selecting official.

Issue Two: Should a technician that already interviewed and was appointed to the entry level WG-08 position need to reapply for a WG 08 position if they need to transfer.?

A lengthy discussion on an E-Mail sent out by COL Tack ensued over the question of a technician having to be in a unit the shop supports. According to letter TN-06-45 Dated 26 July 2006, this is no longer the case. A technician needs to be MOS qualified for the PD that covers their position. If they can not get MOS qualified they would need a waiver. A technician can belong to any unit in the state as long as they are MOS compatible.

HRO has sent an e-mail stating that they are going to put out a letter on the reassignments of technicians. This is to be out shortly according to HRO. Below is email.
