The Ohio National Guard hosts the annual National Rifle and Pistol Matches at Camp Perry Joint Training Center (CPJTC) in Port Clinton, Ohio, in partnership with the National Rifle Association (NRA) and the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP). The National Matches include both the NRA National Rifle and Pistol Championships and the CMP National Trophy Pistol and Rifle Matches.

Known as the “Super Bowl” of competitive shooting, the 2010 National Rifle and Pistol Matches will run July 11 through August 18. The event brings more than 6,000 national and international competitors, volunteers, spectators, vendors and family members to CPJTC each summer. Overall the National Matches have an economic impact of \$20 million to the region.

As a result of construction and service member training at CPJTC, more than \$24 million were brought to the Northeastern region, in 2009.

CPJTC offers year-round fun and relaxation for the entire family. Located on the shores of Lake Erie, visitors will find unspoiled beaches and access to local attractions. It features one of the world’s largest shooting range complexes and a state-of-the-art conference center.
