*Captain Nicholas Rozanski was a member of the Ohio Army National Guard's 1st Battalion, 148th Infantry Regiment of the 37th Infantry Brigade Combat Team when he was killed by a motorcycle suicide bomber in Afghanistan on April 4, 2012. In 2003, Nick decided to join the Ohio National Guard where he served for eight and a half years. The military was a natural fit for Nick and he excelled at it. Nick was very modest about his military service and never wanted the public recognition for it. He simply felt that he was doing what was right for his country. Nick was awarded the Bronze Star, Purple Heart and Combat Action Badge for his bravery and valor in Afghanistan.*
