WEEK IN REVIEW

- W** **JANUARY 12, 1888:** The 14th Infantry Regiment armory, located on the corner of Spring and Front streets in Columbus, catches fire at 6 a.m. and is completely destroyed.
- Th** **JANUARY 13, 1947:** Thomas J. Herbert is inaugurated as the 56th Governor of Ohio. Herbert, a former lieutenant colonel in the Ohio National Guard, was the first commander of the 112th Observation Squadron, 37th Division Aviation. He is the last Ohio governor to have served in the Ohio National Guard.
- Sa** **JANUARY 15, 1952:** The 37th Infantry Division is ordered into active federal service for the Korean War and sent to Camp Polk, La. for training.
- Su** **JANUARY 16, 1993:** The 121st Fighter Wing is redesignated as the 121st Air Refueling Wing.

WOOL FIELD JACKET, "IKE JACKET"

Worn by Sgt. Wolfgang Filusch in January 1952 when his unit, Medical Company, 145th Infantry, was ordered into active federal service with the 37th Infantry Division.

The waist length olive drab jacket was adopted by the Army during World War II as a field uniform and was based upon British battle dress. Rarely used in the field, it quickly became the Army service uniform and was worn through the 1950s.
