**M** AUGUST 5, 1877: The 945th Engineer Company is organized in Norwalk as Company G, 16th Infantry Regiment (Western Reserve Guards).

AUGUST 5, 1917: The Ohio National Guard is drafted into federal service for World War I.

AUGUST 5, 1943: The 37th Infantry Division captures Munda Airfield and the Battle of New Georgia comes to an end.

**Th** AUGUST 8, 1868: Battery A, 1st Battalion, 174th Air Defense Artillery Regiment is organized in Cincinnati as the Cincinnati Zouaves.

CITATION: The President of the United States of America, in the name of Congress, takes pleasure in presenting the Medal of Honor to Private Samuel Grimshaw, United States Army, for extraordinary heroism on 6 August 1864, while serving with Company B, 52d Ohio Infantry, in action at Atlanta, Georgia. Private Grimshaw saved the lives of some of his comrades, and greatly imperiled his own by picking up and throwing away a lighted shell which had fallen in the midst of the company.
