

Officers High Jump trophy won by 1st Lt. Newell C. Bolton from Troop A, 107th Cavalry on Aug. 24, 1921, while riding his horse, Spotlight. The silver cup was presented by Lyon & Morgan, a drug store located in Ravenna, Ohio. Bolton later commanded the 107th Cavalry before his promotion to brigadier general and commanding general of the 54th Cavalry Brigade.
