OCTOBER 15, 1940: The 37th Infantry Division is inducted into federal service by order of the president and sent to Camp Shelby, Miss. for 12 months of training.

OCTOBER 15, 1962: The 178th Wing, 179th Cyberspace Wing and 180th Fighter Wing are allotted to the Ohio Air National Guard and receive federal recognition as the 178th, 179th and 180th Tactical Fighter Groups in Springfield, Mansfield and Toledo, respectively.

This album contains photos from Pvt. Roger Smith, who was a member of Battery D, 136th Field Artillery, 37th Division at Camp Shelby, Miss. A native of Lima, Smith was inducted with his battery on Oct. 15, 1940, and arrived at Camp Shelby a few days later. This leatherbound album could be purchased by Soldiers to hold their photos and other mementos from their time in the Army. The coat of arms of the United States and the shoulder sleeve insignia of the 37th Division are embossed and painted on the cover.
