ADJUTANTS GENERAL MAKE FRIENDLY WAGER

COLUMBUS (November 17, 2006) — Ohio's Adjutant General, Maj. Gen. Greg Wayt, and Michigan's Adjutant General Maj. Gen. Thomas Cutler have agreed to a friendly wager on what some call the "game of the century" between the number one ranked Ohio State University Buckeyes and number two ranked University of Michigan Wolverines.

The general representing the losing team has agreed to pose for a photo while wearing the opposing university's jersey.

"I can not remember a time when the OSU vs. Michigan game had so much riding on the outcome," Wayt said. "Throughout the year, we maintain a great working relationship with the Michigan National Guard, but on Saturday..."

Ohio State, at 11-0, is ranked number one in the country, and has been since the beginning of the college football season. The Wolverines boast an 11-0 record and are ranked second in the Bowl Championship Series (BCS) standings.

The 103rd meeting between Ohio State and Michigan will be at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, November 18, at Ohio Stadium in Columbus, Ohio. The winning team will be named the 2006 Big 10 Champion and earn a bid to college football's national championship game on January 8, 2007; at the Tostitos BCS National Championship in Phoenix, Arizona.
