Ohio Army National Guard brigade headquarters returns home

COLUMBUS, Ohio – Maj. Gen. Gregory L. Wayt, Ohio's adjutant general, will greet 140 Soldiers from the Ohio Army National Guard's 371st Sustainment Brigade as they return from their yearlong deployment to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 1 p.m., Saturday, Apr. 18, at the Nutter Center on the Campus of Wright State University, 3640 Colonel Glenn Highway, Dayton, Ohio.

The Soldiers mobilized out of Ft. McCoy, Wisc., where the unit trained to prepare them for their mission in Iraq. The 371st provided oversight and management of units providing logistical support of the Global War on Terrorism.

The unit is based in Kettering, Ohio, but includes Soldiers from throughout the state.
