Ohio Army National Guard unit to return home from deployment

COLUMBUS, Ohio - Maj. Gen. Gregory L. Wayt, Ohio adjutant general, will honor about 200 Citizen-Soldiers of the Ohio Army National Guard's 1st Battalion, 145th Armored Regiment that are scheduled to return from active duty this month in support of the Multinational Force and Observers in the Sinai.

The public is invited to the unit's welcome home ceremony at 7:00 p.m., Thurs, Sept. 17, at E J Thomas Hall, 198 Hill St., Akron, Ohio, 44325.

The 450-person battalion will return in three phases with the first welcome home ceremony scheduled for Sept 17th with approximately 200 Soldiers returning, the second scheduled Sept 23rd with approximately 200 Soldiers returning and the last scheduled Sept 30th with approximately 50 Soldiers returning. Additional press releases will be sent out for the next two by Sept. 20, 2009.

Elements of the 1-145th Armored Regiment have previously mobilized while designated as the 1st Battalion, 107th Cavalry Regiment. These deployments include support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and security missions around Ohio, Michigan and Kosovo.
