CAMP PERRY, Ohio—The Ohio National Guard will conduct an official ground breaking ceremony for a new barracks building at 11 a.m. Oct. 13, 2009, at the Camp Perry Joint Training Center, 1000 Lawrence Road, Port Clinton, Ohio.
