Shoot House to open at Camp Ravenna

COLUMBUS, Ohio — The “first shot” ceremony for the new Camp Ravenna Joint Military Training Center Shoot House will take place at 1 p.m. Monday, July 1. Camp Ravenna is located at 8451 state Route 5, Ravenna, Ohio 44266.

The funding for the shoot house was obtained from a congressional supplement provided by U.S. Rep. Tim Ryan of Ohio's 13th Congressional District.

Brig. Gen. John C. Harris Jr., Ohio assistant adjutant general for Army; Col. Chip Tansill, Ohio Army National Guard chief of staff; Chief Warrant Officer 5 Jay Stuckman, state command chief warrant officer; and Command Sgt. Maj. Rodger Jones, state command sergeant major, will enter the shoot house and fire the ceremonial first shot as a group.

After the completion of the formal portion of the ceremony, the team of Soldiers will conduct another entry using non-lethal training ammunition to allow media to get video footage from the elevated walkways around the shoot house.
