This branding guide is the identity and standard for the Adjutant General's Department of Ohio and the Ohio National Guard.

THE BRAND



Branding is the process of creating a distinct identity that promotes positive perceptions of the values, character, services, or recognizable images of the organization. The goal of branding is to differentiate the organization from competitors while consistently developing loyal stakeholders and audiences through acknowledged symbols, styles, and narratives. Branding shapes a collective awareness of who the organization is and how it effectively approaches marketing, public affairs, public information, and self-identity.

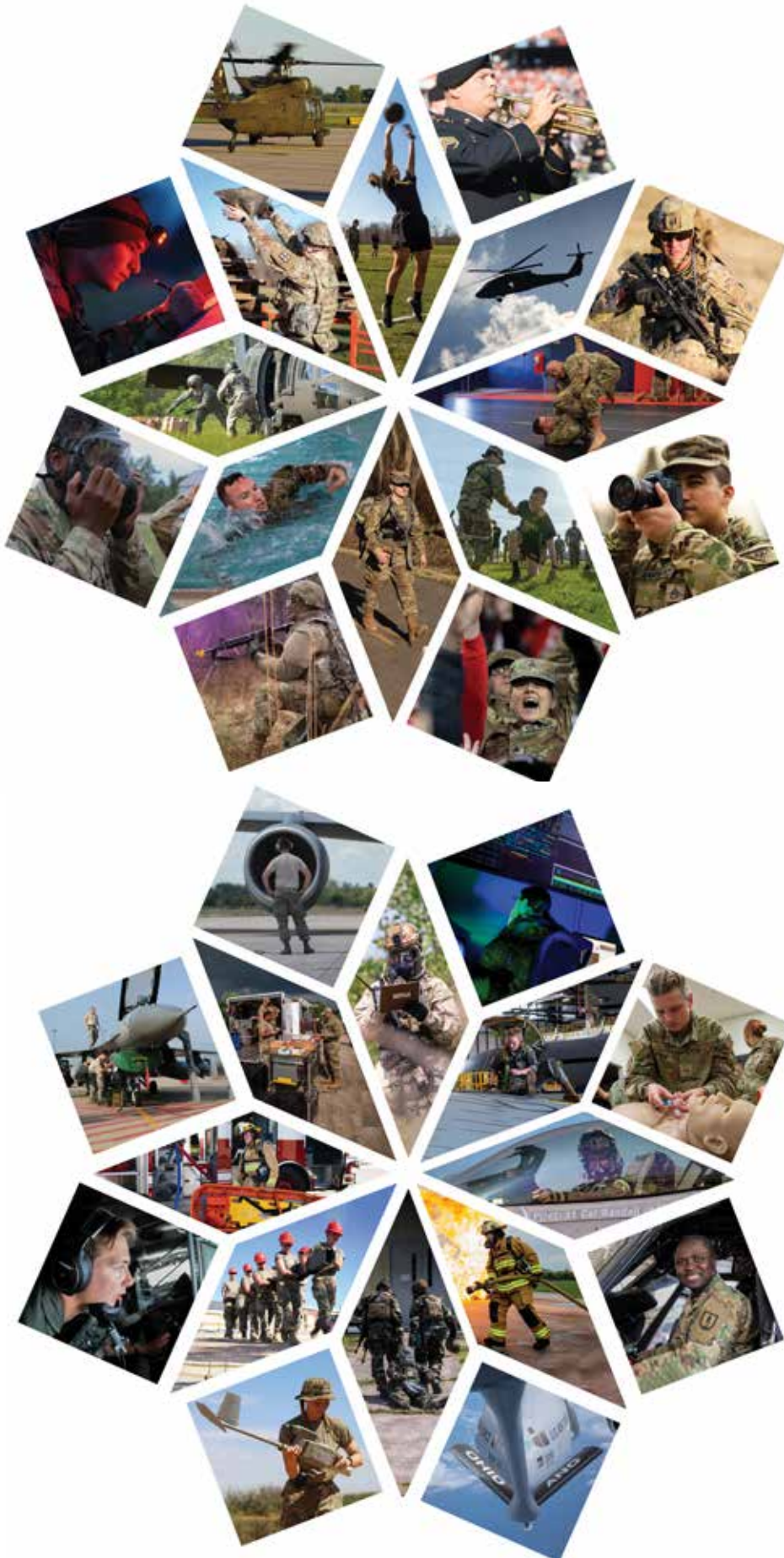
Elements of successful branding include:

- Creates simple but established symbols and images. Applies logos, elements of design, themes, and messages consistently.
- Uses specific and authorized formats for internal/external products (correspondence/email, presentations, and social media).
- Identifies guidelines/authorizations for when, how, where, and who can apply branding.
- Reinforces clarity of purpose — what the organization does that makes it unique.
- Cultivates character — elicits a shared identity among members, a distinguishable product for consumers and others.

The Adjutant General's Department of Ohio (ADJ) is part of the executive branch of government serving as the state's military agency. The Adjutant General of the State of Ohio (TAG-OH) is the Governor's primary military advisor and member of the cabinet.

The ADJ, per the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), is inclusive of the Ohio Army National Guard (OHARNG), Ohio Air National Guard (OHANG), and the State Defense Force (SDF). The SDF includes the Ohio Military Reserve (OHMR), Ohio Naval Militia (OHNM), and the Ohio Cyber Reserve (OhCR). Collectively, all components form the Ohio Organized Militia (Section 5923.01, ORC).

IMAGERY & MESSAGING



IMAGES

The use of imagery is critical in shaping and communicating the personality, values, and stories of a brand to its target audiences. Utilizing strong imagery helps communicate our organization's story and establishes a brand identity that not only catches attention but also forges long-lasting connections with our audiences. Always depict members doing their jobs, to doctrinal standard, in the proper uniform and in compliance with appropriate appearance and physical fitness requirements.

Ohio National Guard imagery released for public use can be found on the Defense Visual Information Distribution Service (DVIDS) website. Search from the main page, utilizing keywords to narrow search parameters, or search directly on the OHNG page or other wing, brigade, and other subordinate OHNG pages.

NOTE: Even imagery obtained from DVIDS should be double-checked to ensure images portray personnel and equipment in compliance with appearance, uniform, safety, training, and positive image standards.

COMMAND

The Great Seal of the State of Ohio is the official seal for the Governor of Ohio.

The Ohio Adjutant General's and Ohio Adjutant General's Department seals incorporate the coat of arms from the Great Seal of the State of Ohio, the official insignia of the U.S. state of Ohio, and therefore are not reproduced, except as required by any provision of the Ohio Constitution and the Revised Code, unless permission to do so is first obtained from The Adjutant General pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5.10.



STATE DEFENSE FORCE (SDF)

The State Defense Force-Ohio is part of the state's Organized Militia and can be called by the Governor to aid civil authorities. It comprises:

- Ohio Cyber Reserve (OhCR)
- Ohio Military Reserve (OHMR)
- Ohio Naval Militia (OHNM)

GOVERNOR

The Governor is the commander in chief of the OHNG and, as such, has the authority to activate the OHNG to support and assist local authorities during state emergencies or for homeland defense.



ADJUTANT GENERAL

The Adjutant General is a member of the Governor's cabinet and is responsible for the command of the OHARNG, OHANG, and SDF.

The Adjutant General supervises the flag officer leadership of these components in the day-to-day operation and management of the readiness, fiscal, personnel, equipment, and real property resources of the agency.



OHIO NATIONAL GUARD ASSISTANT ADJUTANTS GENERAL

The OHNG is the federal component of the ADJ — Comprising the OHARNG and OHANG, the OHNG is affiliated with the Regular Army and United States Air Force, respectively.



OHIO CYBER RESERVE (OhCR)

The Ohio Cyber Reserve is a volunteer force under the command of The Adjutant General. It comprises trained and organized civilians that are available to the Governor to assist eligible municipalities with cybersecurity vulnerabilities and provide recommendations to reduce cyber threats. OhCR volunteers also provide workforce development to train the cyber talent of the future and promote STEM by providing mentors for high school cyber clubs, events, and activities.

OHIO MILITARY RESERVE (OHMR)

The Ohio Military Reserve is a volunteer civilian force drawn from Ohio citizens. Upon declaration of a state emergency, the Ohio Military Reserve can aid civil authorities through medical and logistical support, as well as volunteer reception and management across the state.

The Ohio Naval Militia is an organized, all-volunteer naval unit. Its active mission is to patrol the weapons range impact area off Camp Perry, on Lake Erie, during use of the ranges and to augment the state of Ohio during declared emergencies.

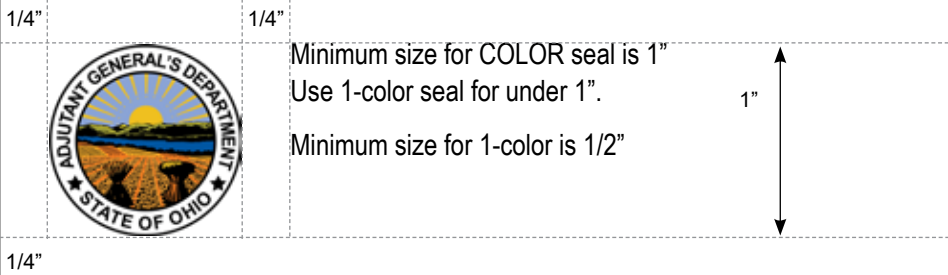
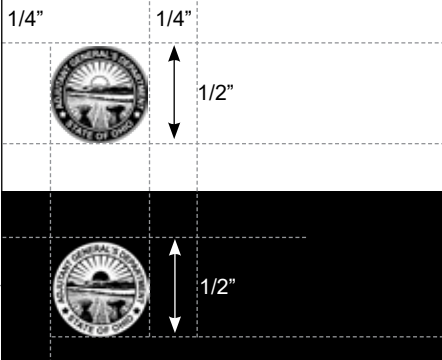

PRIMARY IDENTIFICATION

COLOR

The Adjutant General's Department seal is the only identification to be used for the State Defense Force and its subordinates.

SECONDARY IDENTIFICATION

State Defense Force logos may be used in conjunction with the Adjutant General's Department seal to convey that sub-element's unique identity.

When displayed in the same product (for example, flyers, announcements, or banners in PowerPoint presentations), the secondary logo(s) is displayed at 80% the size of the seal, in order to visually maintain the Adjutant General's Department seal as the master branding graphic element for the organization.

Secondary SDF identification should appear in the following order - left to right: as applicable:



BUSINESS CARDS

Business cards will display either SDF, OhCR, OHMR, or OHNM logos respectively, with QR codes to their webpage. Requests will go through the G6 and adhere to all guidelines as outlined.

Outside vendors are **NOT** authorized to print business cards.

OUTLOOK SIGNATURE BLOCKS

Signature blocks mimic the vertical business card (with the addition of the Adjutant General's Department seal) and are to be used for **ALL** official email correspondence written on behalf of The Ohio Adjutant General's Department, SDF, and its subordinate units.

Microsoft auto-generated initials, or official military or equivalent civilian photos (professional dress, head shot, solid background) are the only approved images for Microsoft identification circles appearing in emails and on other Microsoft 365 platforms, including Teams. Other avatars, caricatures, symbols, non-identifying photos, or graphics are prohibited.

Military personnel and civilian employees may get a professional photograph (as shown in the approved examples) taken by the GPAO at Beightler Armory in Columbus, for official business purposes. You are encouraged to schedule your photo with the GPAO, but if taking your own, please use the following guidelines to ensure a professional, consistent image (as shown in the examples above). Head should take up approximately 1/3 of the circle, use a solid background, look directly at the camera.

The examples here (inclusive, but not exhaustive) show what **IS NOT an approved image** to use as an identifying image for your professional Microsoft office account, including Outlook and Teams identification circles.

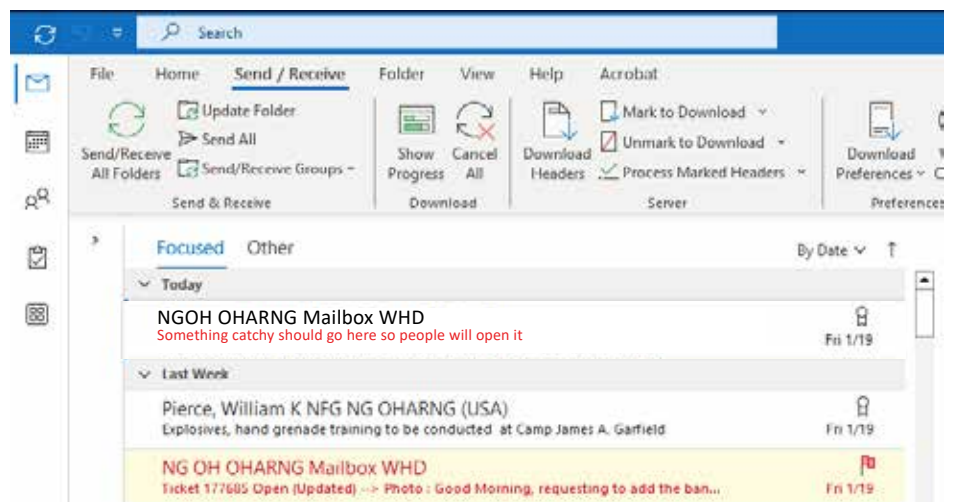


SUBJECT LINES

Make sure you remember to keep your subject line concise to avoid it getting cut off in the inbox. Your subject line should be able to convey urgency, excitement, intrigue, feelings of welcomeness, or whatever the goal of your email message is in a few short words.

- Keep it concise and compelling.
- Start with more important information.
- Create a sense of urgency.
- Get people curious enough to click.
- Don't get too excited.
- Make a personal connection.
- Include call to action, such as "For your review..."

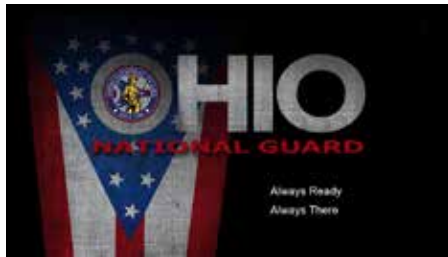

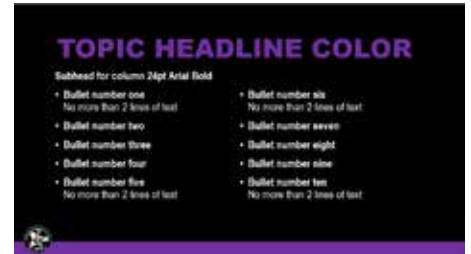

Use Associated Press (AP style) when contributing products to the OHNG public affairs mission. AP abbreviations are widely recognized by the military and general public alike, and also mirror those abbreviations utilized by police and fire organizations as well as other entities that use ranks in their structure. When writing for external (public) audiences, it is recommended to write out the ranks fully or use AP style. Service-specific style should only be used for internal audiences. Applicability is at the discretion of the respective chains of command. Whatever style you use for your document or product, BE CONSISTENT; write it the same way every time.
