Employees (T5 and T32)	Enrollment for TSP Participants	

Background: On September 23rd, 2020, the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) published bulletin #20-7 which released information about increased automatic enrollment percentages with the Thrift Savings Plans for Civilian and Military participants. Increasing the automatic enrollment rate to 5% ensures that each participant receives the full amount of Agency Matching Contributions.

<u>Implementation</u>: On October 1st, 2020, the Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board (FRTIB) will increase the automatic enrollment percentage from 3% to 5% for all Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS) and Civilian Service Retirement System (CSRS) employees who are automatically enrolled in TSP on or after October 1st, 2020.

Was automatically enrolled before 10/1/2020 , and is still contributing at the automatic enrollment rate on	10/1/2020	Remains auto- enrolled at 3% .
Is separated before 10/1/2020 , and then rehired, and subject to automatic enrollment on or after		Is auto-enrolled at 5 %.

This change will not affect the contribution rates in place for FERS and CSRS participants who were automatically enrolled in TSP prior to October 1st, 2020.
