## Ohio Army National Guard engineer brigade headquarters to deploy

COLUMBUS, Ohio — About 100 Soldiers from Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 16th Engineer Brigade, located in Columbus, are deploying for approximately one year in support of U.S. Central Command.
