Showcase your creativity beyond the 9-to-5. Ohio's full-time state employees are invited to highlight their artistic talents in the Ohio Arts Council's Riffe Gallery juried exhibition *After Hours: Artwork by State of Ohio Employees*.

The exhibition will celebrate the artistic talent of anyone employed full-time by the state of Ohio. Professional, emerging, or amateur—all levels of artistic experience are encouraged to apply, and all medium will be accepted (photography, painting, sculpture, drawing, etc.).

A panel of three jurors—Stephanie Rond, artist, arts advocate, and *After Hours* exhibition consultant; Mary Cusick, director, TourismOhio; and Kevin Milstead, deputy director, Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Human Resources—will select the artwork in a blind jury process. The artwork will be on display in the OAC Riffe Gallery, located in the Vern Riffe Center for Government & the Arts in downtown Columbus, May 4 – July 8, 2017.
